This day offers a chance to immerse yourself in the rich cultural and architectural tapestry of Casablanca.

Day 2: Casablanca ~ Marrakech ~ City Tour

Day 3: Marrakech ~ Ait Ben Haddou ~ Ouarzazate ~ Dades Valley

In the morning, you'll be collected from your accommodation in Marrakech, marking the commencement of an unforgettable journey from Marrakech to the Dades Gorges via the High Atlas Mountains. Ascend through the scenic Tizi N'Tichka pass (2,260m), treating yourself to breathtaking views of picturesque villages nestled on the mountainsides.

Continuing our adventure, we travel to Ouarzazate, often referred to as the Hollywood of Africa, traversing the rugged stone desert landscape. Our first stop is the remarkable Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou, a fortified village recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage site and a backdrop for renowned films like *Gladiator*, *Game of Thrones*, and *Lawrence of Arabia*. Explore its narrow alleys and intricate architecture that tell tales of cinematic history. Following this, discover the historic Kasbah of Taourirt and the renowned film studios.

After a satisfying lunch, embark on a scenic journey through the Dades Valley along the famous Road of a Thousand Kasbahs. Pass through the charming town of Skoura, celebrated for its myriad Kasbahs, and continue to Kelaat Magouna, renowned for its fragrant roses. Upon reaching Boumalne Dades, savour a delightful dinner before returning to your hotel.

This day's exploration promises a rich tapestry of landscapes, cinematic history, and cultural treasures as you venture from Marrakech to the enchanting Dades Gorges.

Day 4: Todra Gorges ~ Merzouga Sahara Desert

Embark on a morning journey through ever-changing landscapes en route to the captivating dunes of Merzouga. Traverse the Tinghir oasis, meandering through palm groves that lead to the awe-inspiring Todra Gorges. Here, limestone cliffs create a stunning rift between the majestic mountains of the Todra Massif, descending into the flat riverbed below. Peaks soar up to 320 meters above the winding Todra Gorge, originating in the High Atlas Mountains. Leisurely explore the gorges and palm groves at your own pace. Following a hearty lunch, the tour continues through Tinjdad and Erfoud, both adorned with flourishing palm groves.

The 14-Day Morocco Tour progresses to its enchanting climax – the Merzouga Desert. Immerse yourself in the experience of a camel ride through the mesmerising, undulating dunes of Erg Chebbi. Pause to witness a breathtaking sunset, illuminating the vast golden sand dunes that sculpturally shift in the twilight. Observe the colours transforming with the shifting light intensity, resembling living desert walls,

with the tallest dunes reaching an impressive 150 meters.

The journey concludes with a magical night under the stars in nomadic tents, creating an unforgettable ambiance. Indulge in a delicious dinner accompanied by a musical feast featuring Berber drums played by locals. Undoubtedly, this night in the heart of the desert will stand out as one of the highlights of your 14-day adventure.

After enjoying breakfast at the camp, embark on a camel ride back to the dune line where your driver awaits. Begin your exploration of the high dunes of Merzouga with a comprehensive tour of the surrounding area. Visit key points including Hassi Lbeid, Tanamoust, and Khamlia, where you can immerse yourself in African music. Continue your journey towards the nomads, gaining insights into their lifestyle and unique way of life, and savour the taste of a traditional Berber pizza.

Following this cultural excursion, head to Merzouga for a delightful lunch. Explore the enchanting Hassilbeid Oasis, and relish a panoramic view of Merzouga, capturing the beauty of the landscape. As the late afternoon unfolds, your driver will transport you to your accommodation, where you will spend the night, concluding another day of immersive experiences in the mesmerizing Merzouga region.

Day 6: Merzouga desert ~ Erfoud ~ Ziz Valley ~ Midelt

Following breakfast at your riad in Merzouga, your 14-day desert journey unfolds as we head to the city of Midelt. En route, we pass through Erfoud, renowned as the capital of dates and celebrated for its fossil treasures. Immerse yourself in the city's cultural richness by exploring some museums before continuing towards Errachidia. Pause to appreciate the breathtaking view over the village of Aoufous.

Our journey then takes us to Errachidia, where a well-deserved lunch break awaits. Afterward, we proceed towards Midelt, traversing the Tizi N Talghamt pass. As we arrive in Midelt, known as "the apple capital," in the late afternoon, we'll accompany you to your chosen accommodation. This marks the continuation of your exploration, adding another layer to the diverse experiences of your 14-day desert tour.
