11 Day Experience the Galapagos Islands Cruise

Day 1: Arrive Quito, Ecuador

Day 2: Quito: City Tour & Middle of the World

After enjoying a delicious breakfast, embark on a guided tour of Quito, a city steeped in history and culture. As a UNESCO World Heritage-listed site, Quito's historic centre offers a treasure trove of architectural and cultural wonders. Wander through its cobblestone streets, admire the stunning colonial-era buildings, and visit some of its most iconic landmarks, such as the Basilica del Voto Nacional, a Gothic masterpiece, and the ornate San Francisco Church, and the beautiful La Compañía de Jesús Church, renowned for its ornate gold interior. Along the way, your guide will share fascinating stories about the city's history and its blend of indigenous and Spanish influences.

In the afternoon, journey to the Middle of the World monument (La Mitad del Mundo), located just north of the city. Here, you can stand with one foot in each hemisphere at the equatorial line, an experience that perfectly combines science, history, and fun. Learn about the cultural and geographical significance of this location, and don't forget to take memorable photos to mark the occasion. You may also explore the nearby museum to discover more about the local traditions and scientific experiments related to the equator.

Day 3: Quito ~ Galápagos Islands: Santa Cruz Island: Highlands

Start your day with breakfast before transferring to the airport for your flight to the enchanting Galápagos Islands. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a representative who will assist with your transfer to the cruise ship that will be your home for the next few days. After checking into your cabin, attend a welcome briefing where the crew will provide an overview of the cruise itinerary and important information to ensure you make the most of your journey through this extraordinary archipelago. Take some time to settle in and prepare for the incredible adventure ahead.

This afternoon, your Galápagos adventure begins with a visit to the lush highlands of Santa Cruz Island. Here, the scenery transitions from arid lowlands to a vibrant green landscape. Walk through volcanic craters, explore fascinating lava tunnels, and encounter wild giant tortoises roaming freely in their natural habitat. The Highlands offer an incredible opportunity to experience the island's unique geology and biodiversity up close, setting the tone for the extraordinary journey ahead.

Day 4: Isabela Island: Tintoreras & Wetlands & Interpretation Centre

Start your day with a visit to Tintoreras, a group of volcanic islets near Puerto Villamil. See white-tipped reef sharks, marine iguanas, and blue-footed boobies, and snorkel in crystal-clear waters teeming with marine life.

In the afternoon, explore Isabela's Wetlands, a network of lagoons and mangroves home to birds such as flamingos. Visit the Interpretation Centre to learn about the island's volcanic history, conservation projects, and local culture.

Day 5: Isabela Island: Moreno Point ~ Fernandina Island: Mangle Point

p>Marvel at Moreno Point's dramatic volcanic landscapes with clear lagoons surrounded by mangroves. Spot wildlife such as flamingos and herons as you explore this unique environment.

Later, travel to Fernandina Island, considered one of the most pristine ecosystems in the Galápagos.

Snorkel at Mangle Point or explore its coast, where you may encounter sea lions, turtles, and colourful fish.

Day 6: Fernandina Island: Espinoza Point ~ Isabela Island: Tagus Cove

Visit Espinoza Point on Fernandina Island, home to marine iguanas, flightless cormorants, and playful sea lions. Walk along the rugged coastline, enjoying the stunning views.

In the afternoon, return to Isabela Island to explore Tagus Cove. Hike to a viewpoint overlooking Darwin Lake and volcanic landscapes, or snorkel to observe penguins, marine life, and vibrant fish.

Day 7: Santiago Island: Buccaneer Cove ~ Egas Port

Begin your day at Buccaneer Cove, located on the northwestern coast of Santiago Island. Take a panga ride along dramatic red tuff cliffs and discover natural formations like the 'Elephant Head.' This sheltered bay was once a pirate hideout and is now a haven for nesting seabirds, Galapagos fur seals, and playful sea lions. Enjoy opportunities to snorkel or kayak among colorful tropical fish and the occasional sea turtle in crystal-clear waters.

In the afternoon, disembark at Egas Port on Santiago's western shore. Walk along striking black sand beaches, explore rugged lava pools, and spot endemic Galapagos fur seals lounging in sheltered grottos. Keep an eye out for lava lizards, tide pool invertebrates, and a variety of shorebirds as you wander this wild landscape shaped by volcanic history.

Day 8: Bartolome: Bartolome ~ Santiago: Sullivan Bay

Start your morning with a visit to Bartolome Island, famed for its beautiful lunar landscape and the iconic Pinnacle Rock. Hike to the summit for a spectacular panoramic view of the surrounding islands, volcanic spatter cones, and turquoise bays below. Descend for a refreshing snorkel at the island's golden beach, where you may swim alongside Galapagos penguins, sea turtles, and vibrant reef fish in warm, shallow water.

Spend your afternoon at Sullivan Bay, on the southeastern coast of Santiago. Walk across extensive 'pahoehoe' lava fields formed by volcanic eruptions just over a century ago and observe the patterns and textures of fresh basalt rock. This area offers a fascinating look at the volcanic forces that continue to shape the Galapagos archipelago.

Day 9: Chinese Hat: Chinese Hat ~ Sant Cruz: Dragon Hill

Wake up anchored off the unique islet of Chinese Hat, named for its distinctive conical shape. Walk a short loop trail past lava tubes and white sand beaches, observing sea lions basking on the shore and Galapagos hawks or marine iguanas among the rocks. Snorkelers can encounter vibrant schools of fish, white-tipped reef sharks, and, if lucky, curious Galapagos penguins darting through the water.

In the afternoon, venture to Dragon Hill on Santa Cruz Island. Follow a trail through arid landscapes dotted with palo santo trees and ladder-topped cacti, and search for land iguanas in their natural habitat. The trail also offers panoramic views of saltwater lagoons where flamingos and other wading birds often feed, making this a favorite spot for both wildlife and scenic vistas.

Day 10: Santa Cruz Island: Black Turtle Cove ~ Quito

End your Galápagos adventure with a visit to Black Turtle Cove on Santa Cruz Island. Glide through peaceful mangroves by panga, spotting sea turtles, rays, and reef sharks.

Afterwards, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Quito. Upon arrival, you can utilise the hotels airport shuttle to transfer to your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to relax, explore the city, or indulge in some last-minute shopping. This is your chance to soak up the charm of Quito one final time before concluding your adventure.

Enjoy a restful evening as you prepare for your onward journey the following day.
