2 PEOPLE: 12 Day Danube & Rhine Christmas Markets

***IMPORTANT NOTE:** Any extra nights, optional tours or other amendments, will not be visible on this itinerary.

Day 1: Arrive Munich, Germany

Welcome to Munich. Upon arrival, make your own way to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

You may wish to take a gentle stroll through the city, relax after your flight, or begin soaking up the festive atmosphere ahead of the Christmas markets to come.

Day 2: Munich ~ Passau, Germany ~ Embark Ship

After breakfast this morning, make your own way to the train station and board your train to Passau. The journey takes approximately 2.5 hours and is a comfortable way to travel through the Bavarian countryside.

Welcome to Passau, the starting point of your festive Danube River cruise. Known as the City of Three Rivers, Passau sits at the meeting point of the Danube, Inn, and Ilz rivers and is famous for its baroque architecture, rich church history, and charming old town.

On arrival, you may have some free time to explore Passau before embarkation. Wander through the historic centre with its pastel-coloured buildings and cobbled streets, or visit St Stephen's Cathedral, home to one of the world's largest cathedral organs.

This afternoon, transfer to the ship and embark on your festive Danube River cruise. Settle into your cabin and enjoy the atmosphere as the ship departs Passau and begins its journey along the Danube, surrounded by wintry scenery and Christmas cheer.

NOTE: Luggage lockers are available at Passau train station if required. The group transfer from the train station to the ship departs at 3:00 pm, so please ensure you are at Passau station by this time.

Day 3: Wachau Valley ~ Vienna, Austria

Day 4: Dürnstein ~ Melk, Austria

This morning, arrive in the picturesque village of Dürnstein, one of the most celebrated stops along the Austrian Danube. Nestled among vineyard covered hills, Dürnstein is where terraced vineyards meet medieval architecture.

Enjoy time at leisure to wander through the charming old town, visit the distinctive blue tower of Dürnstein Abbey, or take a short walk up to the ruins of Dürnstein Castle. It was here that England's King Richard the Lionheart was famously imprisoned in the 12th century. From the castle ruins, enjoy sweeping views across the Danube and the surrounding Wachau Valley.

This afternoon, arrive in Melk, often referred to as the Gateway to the Wachau Valley. Dominating the town is the magnificent Melk Abbey, a UNESCO World Heritage listed Benedictine monastery perched

high above the Danube.

Spend time exploring Melk at your leisure, admiring the abbey's impressive baroque architecture and enjoying panoramic views across the river and surrounding countryside. The blend of historic charm and natural beauty makes Melk a memorable highlight of your festive Danube cruise.

During the Christmas season, the city becomes especially enchanting, with several Christmas markets spread throughout the old town. Wander through festive stalls, sample seasonal treats, and soak up the cheerful atmosphere set against baroque squares and beautifully illuminated landmarks.

Spend the day at leisure exploring the old town, strolling along the Danube promenade, or visiting one of Linz's museums and galleries. As evening approaches, return to the ship and continue your festive journey along the Danube.

This afternoon, soak up the festive atmosphere at the Christmas markets located near the cathedral. You may wish to sample a traditional Weckmänner, a classic German yeast pastry, and enjoy a warming cup of hot punch as the stalls glow with seasonal lights.

Later this evening, transfer to the ship and embark on your Christmas cruise along the Rhine. Settle into your cabin, enjoy your first dinner onboard, and begin your magical journey through Europe's festive heartland.

You may choose to enjoy time at leisure or join an optional guided excursion to experience Rudesheim in full Christmas splendour. Stroll through the atmospheric Christmas market, visit the town's charming marketplace, wander along the famous Drosselgasse, and enjoy views along the Rhine promenade. You may also see Germany's largest nativity scene, a true seasonal highlight.

If you prefer not to return to the ship immediately, you may stay in the old town and enjoy the peaceful festive atmosphere at your own pace.

Day 9: Germersheim (Speyer), Germany

Guten Tag and welcome to Germersheim, your gateway to the historic city of Speyer. With a history spanning more than 2,000 years, Speyer is one of Germany's oldest cities and is especially atmospheric in the lead up to Christmas.

During your time ashore, we recommend visiting the magnificent Speyer Cathedral, the city's most important landmark and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This Romanesque masterpiece dominates the skyline and is considered one of the most significant buildings of its kind in Europe.

You may choose to explore independently or join one of the optional excursions below, offering a deeper insight into the Palatinate region and its rich history, wine culture, and picturesque towns.

Return to the ship this evening and continue your festive Rhine River cruise.

Day 10: Strasbourg (Kehl), France

This morning, arrive in Kehl and cross into Strasbourg, widely regarded as the Capital of Christmas. During the festive season, Strasbourg is truly magical, with glittering Christmas markets, medieval half-timbered houses, and elegant city palaces beautifully decorated for the season.

The absolute highlight is Strasbourg Cathedral, an extraordinary Gothic masterpiece that dominates the skyline. From its observation deck, enjoy breathtaking views across the city, which resemble a miniature railway landscape during the Christmas period.

Spend time exploring the atmospheric old town, known as La Petite France, with its canals, cobbled streets, and charming shopfronts. You may choose to explore independently or join the optional excursion below to experience Strasbourg in greater depth.

Return to the ship this evening and continue your festive Rhine River cruise.

This morning, arrive in historic Wiesbaden, one of Germany's oldest spa cities with more than 2,000 years of history. During the Christmas season, Wiesbaden is particularly atmospheric, with festive lights, seasonal stalls, and a traditional Christmas market set around Schlossplatz (Palace Square) and the striking Marktkirche (Market Church). The illuminated church and surrounding historic buildings create a wonderful festive setting, ideal for exploring at a relaxed pace.

Alternatively, you may choose to join an optional excursion to nearby Mainz, just across the Rhine. Here, discover a charming old town shaped by Roman heritage, half-timbered houses, and the impressive Mainz Cathedral. Located in the heart of Germany's wine country, Mainz offers a rich blend of history, culture, and seasonal traditions, especially lively during the Christmas period.

This afternoon, sit back and relax as the ship cruises through the legendary Loreley Valley. Steep cliffs, wintry forests, and charming riverside villages line this famous stretch of the Rhine. According to legend, the Loreley, a beautiful nymph, once sat atop the cliffs and lured sailors with her song, a tale that continues to capture the imagination.

Arrive in Koblenz in the early evening and enjoy time ashore before returning to the ship. Stroll through the city and admire its festive lights and picturesque riverside setting at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. Back on board, delicious culinary delights await.
