11 Day Luxury Sri Lanka Escape with Flights

Day 1: Depart Australia ~ Arrive in Sri Lanka

Today, you'll begin your journey to the beautiful island of Sri Lanka! Upon arrival at Colombo's Bandaranaike International Airport, you will be greeted by your driver and transferred to your Hotel in Negombo. Most flights from Australia arrive late at night (from 10:30 pm onwards). After reaching your hotel, check in and head straight to bed for a good night's rest.

Day 3: Colombo ~ Sigiriya

for wildlife and nature enthusiasts, the park forms part of an important elephant corridor linking Minneriya with Kaudulla and Wasgamuwa National Parks. It is renowned for its elephant sightings throughout the year.

Following your safari, continue to the renowned Aliya Resort & Spa, your home for the next two nights. Set amidst beautiful countryside with spectacular views towards the iconic Sigiriya Rock, the resort offers a tranquil setting to relax and unwind following your wildlife adventure.

Day 4: Polonnaruwa City Tour

After breakfast, travel to Polonnaruwa, the medieval capital of Sri Lanka from 1017 to 1235 AD. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1982, Polonnaruwa offers a captivating insight into Sri Lanka's rich medieval history and cultural heritage.

Following your sightseeing tour, enjoy a refreshing king coconut drink before beginning your return journey to Sigiriya through the island's beautiful rural countryside. Along the way, enjoy an exclusive and authentic rural Sri Lankan experience, including lunch and an opportunity to discover the country's traditional agricultural lifestyle and local culture. Depending on your interests and the arrangements available on the day, the experience may include an introduction to traditional farming practices, a glimpse into local village life, and a cultural presentation featuring traditional Sri Lankan folk songs and dancing. Enjoy a freshly prepared traditional Sri Lankan lunch, made using locally sourced ingredients, while experiencing the warmth and hospitality of the rural community. Continue to Sigiriya and spend the remainder of the day at leisure. Relax at your hotel and unwind in the peaceful surroundings.

Day 5: Sigiriya ~ Kandy

Return to the hotel for breakfast before beginning your journey towards Kandy. En route, stop in the city of Matale to visit a traditional spice garden. Discover Sri Lanka's rich variety of spices and learn about their importance in the island's culinary, cultural and Ayurvedic traditions.

Continue to Kandy, Sri Lanka's cultural capital and the country's second-largest city. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy some time to relax and refresh. This evening, experience a traditional Kandyan cultural performance, featuring vibrant costumes, rhythmic drumming, traditional dances and captivating performances that showcase the island's rich artistic heritage. This lively cultural experience offers a wonderful introduction to the traditions and performing arts of Sri Lanka's hill country. Following the cultural performance, enjoy some free time to explore Kandy at your own pace. Take a leisurely stroll around picturesque Kandy Lake, browse the local shops and lively streets, or simply soak up the atmosphere of this historic city. Day 6: Kandy ~ Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast, visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of Sri Lanka's most revered Buddhist sites and an important cultural landmark in Kandy. Located within the historic Royal Palace complex, the temple is believed to house a sacred relic of the Buddha and attracts pilgrims and visitors from around the world.

Continue with a visit to a gem museum, where you'll discover Sri Lanka's long-standing tradition of gemstone mining and craftsmanship. Learn more about the country's gem industry, traditional mining methods and the intricate process of cutting and polishing these beautiful stones. Afterwards, continue your journey towards Sri Lanka's spectacular central highlands. As you gradually ascend into the hills, the landscape transforms dramatically, with winding mountain roads, lush green valleys, cascading waterfalls and extensive tea plantations carpeting the surrounding slopes. Enjoy the panoramic scenery along the way as you make your way towards Nuwara Eliya, often referred to as "Little England" for its cool climate and distinctive colonial-era character.

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure. Relax and unwind in the refreshing mountain climate, or take a leisurely stroll through the town and soak up the peaceful atmosphere of Sri Lanka's scenic hill country.

Day 7: Nuwara Eliya City Tour

hills, lush tea plantations and mist-covered valleys.

Following your hike, continue to a nearby tea factory and discover the fascinating journey of Ceylon tea, from freshly picked leaves to the world-famous tea enjoyed around the globe. The factory retains some of its original machinery, offering an authentic glimpse into traditional tea production. Learn how the leaves are carefully withered, rolled, fermented, dried and graded to create the distinctive character of Ceylon black tea. For a more hands-on experience, take part in a tea-plucking experience, joining local tea pluckers among the emerald-green plantations and learning how the finest tea leaves are carefully selected. This provides a wonderful opportunity to experience an important part of everyday life in Sri Lanka's picturesque hill country.

Later, enjoy a quintessential Nuwara Eliya experience at the Grand Tea Lounge, one of the town's celebrated venues. Set within the historic Grand Hotel, relax in elegant surroundings and indulge in an iconic High Tea, accompanied by a selection of delicate savouries, pastries and sweet treats, while soaking up the timeless colonial atmosphere of Nuwara Eliya. Return to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure..

Day 8: Nuwara Eliya ~ Scenic Train Ride ~ Wellawaya

Continue along the ancient ramparts, with sweeping views across the Indian Ocean. As the afternoon unfolds, make your way to one of the fort's iconic oceanfront vantage points. Pause to watch the sun slowly dip towards the horizon as the sky transforms into warm, golden hues, creating a memorable final evening on Sri Lanka's southern coast.

In the evening, join your chauffeur or guide and fellow travellers for a special farewell seafood dinner. Enjoy a selection of fresh, locally sourced seafood in a relaxed setting, while sharing stories, laughter and favourite memories from your journey through Sri Lanka.
